




New & Upcoming Functionality on Skills for All

- Create custom assignments from course resources (May 31)
- Gradebook view instructor can view student's last final attempt and see missed questions (May 31)
- Assessment attempt duration displays in gradebook for instructor (June TBD)
- Final Exam interface displays one questions at a time (June/July TBD)
- Final Exam duration within availability window (June/July TBD)
 - Availability sets the activation window and duration is the length of time to complete the assessment.
 - 00:00 is the default duration which equals unlimited amount of time.
 - A student can start the exam a few minutes before activation window closes and still have the full duration to complete the assessment.




4.2.1 Router-on-a-Stick Scenario

In the previous topic, three different ways to create inter-VLAN routing were listed, and legacy inter-VLAN routing was detailed. This topic details how to configure router-on-a-stick inter-VLAN routing. You can see in the figure that the router is not in the center of the topology but instead, appears to be on a stick near the border, hence the name.

Q BEN /

In the figure, the R1 GigabitEthernet 0/0/1 interface is connected to the S1 FastEthernet 0/5 port. The S1 FastEthernet 0/1 port is connected to the S2 FastEthernet 0/1 port. These are trunk links that are required to forward traffic within and between VLANs.
